## **Moorebank Intermodal Precinct East Stage 2 and Concept Plan Modification 2**

The land I am referring to is on the western side of Moorebank Avenue and fronts the Georges River. This land is owned by the Government and therefore it is owned by the residents of Australia. The Government has no right to give this land to a developer under the pretence of calling it a significant project.

**The two Cumberland Plan endangered ecological communities that exist on the site and are proposed for removal are:** River-flat Eucalyptus Forest on Coastal Floodplains of the NSW North Coast, Sydney Basin and South, 28.47 Hectares and Fresh water Wetlands on Coastal Floodplains of the NSW North Coast, Sydney Basin and South east corner bioregions, 42.69 Hectares.

### **Giving a total area of 71.16 Hectares.**

New South Wales has only 5,446 Hectares left of the River-flat Eucalyptus Forest on Coastal Floodplains and the loss of these areas on the magnificent Georges River within two Kilometres of the City of Liverpool would be a disgrace on our society as humans to allow such devastation to occur because of the agreed for money and the payback of political influence and this is not acceptable in our society as Australians.
